INTRODUCTION:

"But the Lord said to him, "Go, for **he is a chosen instrument of Mine**, to bear My name before the Gentiles and kings and the sons of Israel."

A REVIEW OF CHAPTER 9:

SAUL: GOD'S CHOSEN INSTRUMENT

TWO STATEMENTS SAUL WOULD MAKE ...

- 1. God's gracious work of salvation in my life—His choosing me—is so that I might be an **illustration** of the **transforming power** of the Gospel.
- 2. God's gracious work of salvation in my life—His choosing me—is so that I might be an **instrument** in the **tireless proclamation** of the Gospel.

TWO REMINDERS SAUL WOULD GIVE ...

- **1.** As you carry out the **purpose** for which you have been chosen, you should expect to experience both tremendous **opportunity** and **opposition**.
- 2. As you carry out the **purpose** for which you have been chosen, you must remember that you are the **instrument**, not the **Artist**.

"Now for several days he was with the disciples who were at Damascus, ²⁰ and <u>immediately</u> <u>he began to proclaim Jesus in the synagogues</u>, saying, 'He is the Son of God.' ²¹ All those hearing him continued to be amazed, and were saying, 'Is this not he who in Jerusalem destroyed those who called on this name, and who had come here for the purpose of bringing them bound before the chief priests?' ²² But Saul kept increasing in strength and <u>confounding</u> the Jews who lived at Damascus by **proving that this Jesus is the Christ**."
