**INTRODUCTION:** 

## • OUR SPIRITUAL MATURITY IS NOT ONLY DEVELOPED AND REVEALED BY HOW WE RESPOND TO LIFE'S TRIALS (v. 2-12), BUT ALSO BY HOW WE RESPOND TO GOD'S TRUTH. (v. 19-25). FOR THERE IS A PROMISE OF BLESSING TO BOTH (v. 12, 25).

## • A WORKING DEFINITION OF MATURITY:

"A <u>lifelong</u>, <u>passionate</u> pursuit of God's upward calling in Christ Jesus, experiencing greater <u>intimacy</u> with Him and <u>conformity</u> to Him until the <u>day</u> that I am <u>ultimately</u> with Him and like Him."

"In the exercise of His will **He brought us forth by the word of truth**,..." (v. 18)

## • THE CONTEXT: WORD OF GOD, SPEAK! CHILD OF GOD, LISTEN! (1:19-25)

- Our maturity is in direct correlation to our <u>reception</u> of God's Word (1:19-21) and response to God's Word. (1:22-25)
  - We are to receive it with a heart of humility, purity and expectancy.

"...receive the word implanted,..."

• We are to respond to it with heart of submission and obedience.

"But prove yourselves **doers of the word**, and not merely hearers..."
