INTRODUCTION:

1. MARRIAGE IS THE <u>PRODUCT</u> OF THE <u>CREATIVE WORK</u> OF GOD.

- 2. MARRIAGE IS TO BE <u>PATTERNED</u> AFTER THE <u>COVENANT FAITHFULNESS</u> OF GOD.
- 3. MARRIAGE HAS BEEN <u>PERVERTED</u> (LIKE EVERY OTHER RELATIONSHIP) BY THE <u>CORRUPTING PRESENCE</u> OF SIN.
- 4. MARRIAGE IS POSSIBLE THROUGH THE CONSTRAINING LOVE OF CHRIST.
- 5. MARRIAGE IS TO BE A <u>PICTURE</u> OF THE <u>QUINTESSENTIAL RELATIONSHIP</u> BETWEEN CHRIST AND THE CHURCH.

• DEFINITIONS: MARRIAGE IS AN <u>EXCLUSIVE</u>, <u>PERMANENT</u>, <u>ONE-FLESH</u> RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN A MAN AND A WOMAN WHICH IS <u>ESTABLISHED</u>, <u>GUARDED</u>, <u>GOVERNED</u> AND <u>GUIDED</u> BY A <u>COVENANT</u>.

1A. MARRIAGE IS THE PRODUCT OF THE CREATIVE WORK OF GOD:

 The Divine Intent and Edenic Objective was that marriage, as with every other aspect of life lived within God's Creation, would result in man's <u>flourishing</u>.

2A. MARRIAGE IS TO BE PATTERNED AFTER THE COVENANT LOVE OF GOD.

• As such, it is <u>unconditional</u>, based upon a <u>promise</u>, maintained by <u>faithfulness</u> and expressed in <u>sacrificial</u> commitment.

3A. MARRIAGE HAS BEEN <u>PERVERTED</u> (LIKE EVERY OTHER RELATIONSHIP) BY THE <u>CORRUPTING PRESENCE</u> OF SIN.

 Paradise Lost - What man briefly enjoyed in the original creation before the Fall the <u>unmediated presence</u> of <u>God</u> and the <u>unprecedented absence</u> of <u>shame</u>—was immediately forfeited by man's disobedience.
