3A. PAUL'S _____ THE JOURNEY: (16:1-5)

“Paul came also to Derbe and to Lystra. And **a disciple was there, named Timothy**, the son of a Jewish woman who was a believer, but his father was a Greek, ² and he was well spoken of by the brethren who were in Lystra and Iconium. ³ **Paul wanted this man to go with him**; and he took him and circumcised him because of the Jews who were in those parts, for they all knew that his father was a Greek.”

“But I hope in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, so that I also may be encouraged when I learn of your condition. ²⁰ **For I have no one else of kindred spirit** who will **genuinely be concerned for your welfare**. ²¹ For they all seek after their own interests, not those of Christ Jesus. ²² But **you know of his proven worth** that he served with me in the furtherance of the gospel like a child serving his father.”
