Beautiful Feet: The Global Mission Begun (Acts 7:58-8:8)

INTRODUCTION:

"How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed? How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher? ¹⁵ How will they **preach** unless they are sent? Just as it is written, "HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO **BRING GOOD NEWS** OF GOOD THINGS!"
