INTRODUCTION **NOTES** Revelation chapter 20 gives us a majestic view of what God will do in the days to come. Earlier in the book of Revelation, John saw that the evil one was behind the dragon, antichrist, and false prophet. Now he is seeing the visions and pictures of the Lamb. He assures us that we will get to see the Lamb's Victory. So as we dive into this chapter, we'll see that these 20 verses will be full of all kinds of pictures and images. Allow them to seep into your heart and mind and understand that through these small visions and images, we can have a broad picture of what is to come. KEY POINTS 1. The Lamb If you understand the Old Testament, you realize how important the lamb was during the Passover Feast. Even now, practicing Jews observe the feast that took place in Egypt before God set His people free. It is a picturesque and powerful picture of the Lamb. But that's not the only picture we see in Scripture. The Lamb of God came to this planet on Christmas day. For 33 1/2 years, He lived among men. Those final 3 1/2 years of ministry were to proclaim the Gospel. He came to go to Calvary and shed His blood, for your sin and my sin. Do you get that picture? When you receive Christ as Lord of your life, the blood of the Lamb is over the doorpost of your heart and your life. Thereby, you will not receive the judgment and wrath of God. This is a very exciting picture! Additionally, as John gets another picture of the Lamb and record it in today's key passage, there are several things about the Lamb he points out to us: The Lamb Standing The Lamb Standing on Mt. Zion The Lamb Standing with His Evangelists The Lamb Standing with His Sealed Evangelists The Lamb Standing in the Midst of Worship


QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER
