Let's look at the first one today. **KEY POINTS** 1. The Glimpse Of A Servant's Responsibility When I talk to you about a servant's responsibility, you could say, "I'm not an angel. I'm not even a pastor." When you give your life to Christ, you are under His Lordship, which means you do His bidding. This means you are to think as He thinks and to do what He does. We are representatives of Jesus Christ. We are agents of reconciliation. We are to reflect the light of Christ and call men and women, and young people to follow Jesus. That's what a servant does. We must be willing to do whatever He wants. We must stand for Him wherever He wants us to stand. We must be willing to do the good things but also to sometimes stand and deliver the not-so-good things. You see, that's what a messenger does.
