INTRODUCTION	NOTES
Last time, as we discussed Revelation chapter 15, we saw the wrath of God being described. In today's chapter of focus, this final barrage, seven bowls of wrath are released upon the planet. This wrath is released upon all of the inhabitants, all at the same time. Nothing is held back; all of it happens immediately. Can you imagine all of this happening at once by the hand of God? This is sobering indeed! So as we study this chapter, we learn a lot about what is going to happen in the end times in regards to God's wrath.	
KEY POINTS	
1. A Global Consequence Of Global Rebellion God is bringing judgment. John hears this great voice, this loud voice out of the temple. The word "great" refers to God. You might ask, "Why would God bring judgment?" If you read Chapter 15 again, you understand that God is just. The question we should be asking is, "Why not?" Billy Graham's wife, Ruth Graham, said this years ago, "If God does not judge America, He will have to apologize to Sodom and Gomorrah." The idea of thinking we deserve to be blessed because we are good people is a false presupposition. It is amazing that God has not already judged us. It says a lot about His grace and mercy. God judges man because of His rebellion; then He brings wrath and judgment. 2. A Global Judgment For Global Rejection During the period in the end times where people choose to repent, several things will happen, including the releasing of the seven bowls of wrath: - Cancer - Sea - Rivers and Springs - Sun - Throne of the Beast - The Euphrates - Heavens and Earth
