We're diving into Scripture and making sure we have a clear understanding of our beliefs and our faith so that we are prepared to give a reason regarding the hope that is in us, as Peter says in his first epistle. Today, we're going to continue this conversation by discussing what we believe about salvation and church membership. Let's dive in together. KEY POINTS 1. We Believe Salvation Is A One Time Experience Do you remember the day you were saved? Was it a Monday? Tuesday? Wednesday? While you may not remember what day it was, it is important that you remember the moment you gave your life to Jesus, because that is the moment your life was forever changed. It doesn't make a difference what day it happened. All that matters is that you know there was a day that you gave your life to Christ, that you had that experience of grace. 2. We Believe In A Converted Church Membership To put it bluntly, we don't believe everybody ought to be a member of a church. Instead, we believe that when you have given your life to Jesus, when you have accepted His free gift of salvation, and when you have been converted to Christianity, then you can become a member of the church. After all, it is when you get saved that you become a member of God's family. So it's important that you also become a member of the church family as well.
