What's In A Name? | Zechariah 12:9

3. Jehovah Jireh – “I am the one who provides.”

This is the name that was given to Abraham when he was offering Isaac as a sacrifice. Abraham was instructed to go to a mountain in the area of Moriah and offer his son Isaac as a sacrifice. Why would God do that? I don't know, but God had a plan, and God knew the plan beforehand. He had already put it together.

When they got up to Mount Moriah, the place God had shown him, Abraham raised his knife to sacrifice Isaac. The angel of the Lord called his name twice and Abraham stopped and said, “Here am I,” and held his hand. Then out of nowhere, God provided a ram to sacrifice instead of Isaac. The Bible says Abraham called that place “Jehovah Jireh.” “The Lord will provide.”
