The Final Answer - The Last Judgment

Revelation 20:7-15

INTRODUCTION

Today, we are in Chapter 20 of the Book of Revelation, where we will start with verse 7. This is the end of the judgment of God. We have been spending time with the Great Tribulation, seven years after the rapture of the Church. During this period, the wrath of God is poured out on the planet. So in this message, we are going to look at the different aspects of the last judgment and see what Scripture has to say about this crucial time period.

KEY POINTS

1. A Scriptural Release Of Satan

Satan has been the great deceiver. During the time when Satan is in the Abyss, he is not deceiving anyone. Accordingly, the world gets to see Jesus' reign. Thinking about the context, many believers only look at this world based on what they see physically, financially, economically, and relationally in their world. Behind all of the conflict is the deceiver. Without the knowledge that Satan is behind the deception, we will not have a full picture of what is happening. Satan is behind the evil. When he moves out of the way, all of the deception leaves with him.

2. A Spiritual Deception Upon The Earth

The Bible tells us that when the devil is released, he whispers to the people (like he did with Adam and Eve). When God releases the evil one, he whispers to the nations that have been under the rulership of the Savior King.

This is the devil's M.O. from the Garden of Eden all the way to his end. We need to understand that his nature is to deceive and bring conflict. Scripture tells us that he is the father of lies. That is what he does, not only with Adam and Eve but also with these nations. He will whisper into their hearts and deceive them.

3. A Spiritual War Around Jerusalem

You might say that Jerusalem isn't even mentioned in this passage. But that's not actually the case. In verse 9, hordes of people and nations come against the camp of God's people, the city He loves. Do you know what city that is? It is Jerusalem. I know you may be concerned about what is happening in Moscow and Washington. What happens in Jerusalem affects us all, especially during end times. It is important that we realize that they come against Christ and His people.
