INTRODUCTION	NOTES
Today, we wrap up our series on Revelation. The last chapter of the book of Revelation is about the final answer, God's final answer. It is His final invitation. So as we go through this final chapter today, I want to extend an invitation to you to respond to the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Let's dive in one last time to this incredible book in Scripture.	
KEY POINTS	
1. An Invitation With Inspiration It is important to realize that God is saying this must soon take place. It is a reminder to all God's men, all God's women, and all God's children to speak the words of Jesus and to be focused on Him. This is what it means to be a man or a woman of God, to speak about Jesus. That's the purpose of the church. It is not to be a social ministry; instead, it is to be an evangelistic ministry to call people to faith in Jesus. It will not be important where you went to church or the particular denomination, but rather that Jesus is your Lord. He is your boss and your Savior because you turned from sin and placed your faith in Christ.	
When I look at our present culture, there has never been a time as vile as our current culture. God will only tolerate this for so long before He brings down the kingdoms. Every generation that fails to live with full expectancy will find themselves in a place of full complacency. It is important for us to realize that. Therefore, this is an invitation with inspiration, as John writes.	
2. An Invitation With Confidence As our culture ramps up with vile behavior and ungodly policies, we need to understand that this should give us confidence that it won't be long before we will be leaving here. It could happen in your lifetime or my lifetime; in fact, it could happen today. I might not be able to finish this sermon! That would be okay with me. The Scripture tells us we are to live with that kind of confidence. Jesus is coming again, and we need to live every day as if He is coming today. How He would find you should be utmost on your heart and mind.

4. An Invitation In Partnership In verses 8-10, John is amazed as he comes to the end of the prophecy of the Book of Revelation. As he has seen everything that will happen in the future, he gets a glimpse of heaven. He is so overwhelmed that he falls at the feet of the angel, as though dead. The angel looks at him and says, "Don't do that! I am a fellow servant with you." This is a glimpse of partnership. The angel is saying, "John, I am with you. I am not above you. We are in this together."	NOTES

7. An Invitation Of Urgency In verse 17, the Scripture says, The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let the one who hears say, "Come!" Let the one who is thirsty come; and let the one who wishes take the free gift of the water of life. Do you feel that intensity? Do you feel that sense of urgency? This book ends with a powerful invitation to "Come, come, come!"	
8. An Invitation With Warning In verses 18 and 19, we hear some interesting words. He says, "Don't add to this book, don't add to this scroll." (That's the Book of Revelation.) "Don't take away." There are thousands of cults in our country today. They constantly add other words to their "scripture," and they skew the Book of Revelation to fit their particular twist of theology. God is saying, "I am warning you, Do not add anything."	
9. An Invitation To Be Answered If Jesus came today, how would He find you? Do you know Christ as Lord of your life? If not, I pray that you would turn from sin and place your faith in Jesus today. Don't wait another moment. "Come Lord Jesus." If you can't say, "Come Lord, Jesus," you need to do business with God before you can no longer hear the invitation. God wants you to respond to Him.
