INTRODUCTION

NOTES

You might have a great-looking car with leather seats and every feature imaginable, but if you don't have a battery, you're not going anywhere. Without power, you're stuck in the driveway. Many believers today live the same way, disconnected from the true power source. In Acts 2, we see the "Battery Chapter" of the New Testament. The Holy Spirit came and revolutionized everything. Pentecost was the moment when the church was born, and when God's power filled ordinary people to do extraordinary things. If we want to become Acts 2 believers, we must connect to that same power source. And that begins with one key principle.

KEY POINTS

1. Be Obedient

The key to the blessings of God and the anointing of the Holy Spirit is obedience. Before Jesus ascended into heaven, He told His disciples to “wait in Jerusalem until the Promised One comes.” That was His only command, and they obeyed.

Many of us wonder why the fire seems gone from our walk with Christ. We have all the right pieces, but no power. The answer is simple: obedience. God blesses those who do what He says. As the old hymn reminds us:

“Trust and obey, for there’s no other way
To be happy in Jesus, but to trust and obey.”

Obedience is everything. God's Word must be our flow of life if we want to be Acts 2 believers.
