KEY POINTS	-
1. The Lamb  If you understand the Old Testament, you realize how important the lamb was during the Passover Feast. Even now, practicing Jews observe the feast that took place in Egypt before God set His people free.	
It is a picturesque and powerful picture of the Lamb. But that's not the only picture we see in Scripture. The Lamb of God came to this planet on Christmas day. For 33 ½ years, He lived among men. Those final 3 ½ years of ministry were to proclaim the Gospel.	
He came to go to Calvary and shed His blood, for your sin and my sin. Do you get that picture? When you receive Christ as Lord of your life, the blood of the Lamb is over the doorpost of your heart and your life. Thereby, you will not receive the judgment and wrath of God. This is a very exciting picture!
