INTRODUCTION NOTES In today's message, we are going to continue our study of the names of God. Specifically, we're going to talk about how God is our shepherd and how He takes care of us no matter what we're walking through. Let's dive in. **KEY POINTS** 1. JEHOVAH-ROHI "I am the LORD your shepherd" There is an intimate relationship between the shepherds in Israel and their sheep, especially during Jesus' day. That is why David wrote today's key passage, inspired by the Holy Spirit. David was a shepherd himself and he speaks about this deep relationship. Often, the sheep in Israel would stay with their shepherd for their entire lives. Because of this, they had a deep relationship with the shepherd. The same is true for us and Jesus. As our shepherd, Jesus wants to have a deep relationship with us. When God speaks about being our shepherd, our key passage gives us direction as to what the shepherd is doing in leading us in our lives. - God gives us a Word of Provision. - God gives us a Word of Direction. - God gives us a Word of Purpose. - God gives us a Word of Protection. - God gives us a Word of Security. - God gives us a Word of Legacy. - God gives us a Word of Assurance.
