

## A SMART BOMB STRATEGY

2 Cor. 10:3-5

“**Strategic bombing**, approach to aerial bombardment designed to destroy a country’s ability to wage [war](#) by demoralizing civilians and targeting features of an enemy’s infrastructure—such as factories, railways, and refineries—that are essential for the production and supply of war materials. Some definitions of strategic bombing, however, also include roles for **supporting ground troops** in combat operations. Strategic bombing is a facet of [total war](#), the enlistment of a **society’s entire resources** to aid in a conflict.”

For the last 9 weeks we have examined, 28 of God’s Smart Bombs to Replace an enemy Stronghold within your mind and heart. I want what we have been teaching to sink deep within your heart and life and become part of your story. Knowing who you are in Christ is essential to Spiritual Health! Without it, you are destined to stay in the nursery, drinking milk for the rest of your spiritual life. God has more for you than that!

### 1. **Learn the Basics.**

‘Therefore let us move beyond the elementary teachings about Christ and be taken forward to maturity, not laying again the foundation of repentance from acts that lead to death, and of faith in God.’ Heb. 6:1

**Remember** What a stronghold is; **Refuse** to make peace with the enemy or his thoughts; **Repent** of allowing a stronghold to stay; **Replace** the stronghold with God’s Word.

### 2. **Continue the bombing campaign.**

For the rest of your life you will need to make sure your territory is Holy Spirit occupied. Use your bombs! Don’t just learn more doctrine without putting it into practice.

### 3. **Demolish any existing enemy outposts.**

Thinking wrong things produces doing wrong things. So, are there any habits which you have justified which the Lord Jesus is not honored with in your life. Certain habitual behavior? Certain phrases or topics of speech? Certain lifestyle justifications allowed previously? Certain relationships which are unhealthy and spiritually detrimental to your health as a believer?

### 4. **Link up with ground support.**

As a child of God, you need others in your life to help you grow and mature in the faith. Get involved in a church, attend a small group bible study, start serving to make a difference, begin new spiritual habits which includes connecting with others who are growing in their faith. We all need each other.
