

Remember not the sins and transgression of my youth.






FEASTING AT THE TABLE OF GRACE

*THE GREAT THANKSGIVING




Pastor gives thanks, recalling God's story of abundance.

...And so, with your people on earth and all the company of heaven, we praise your name and join their unending hymn:




Please be seated. Pastor continues leading the prayer, recalling the acts of Christ.
