Response: Outdo one another in showing honor

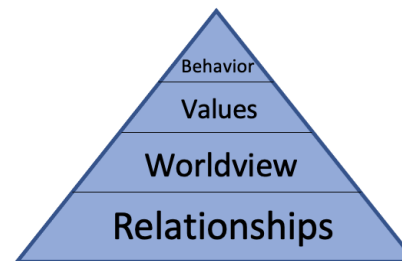
