## **Main Idea:**

## Questions for further contemplation and application after the message:

#1 Read Luke 4:14-20. According to the message today, what was at the heart of Jesus' teaching?

Why do you think the people of Nazareth, Jesus' hometown, rejected him?

#2 What did Peter do right in v. 5?

#3 How did the miraculous catch of fish confirm in Peter's mind that Jesus was the Messiah?

How did the miracle give evidence of Jesus' divinity?

#4 What was Peter's new calling to be (v. 10)?

#5 How did Peter, Andrew, James and John respond to the Lord's call?

What might that kind of commitment/devotion look like for disciples today?

#6 Jesus would again announce Himself to the disciples in like fashion to this occasion after His resurrection. Read John 21:1-14. On that later occasion, Peter hastily "threw himself into the sea" to swim to shore so he could get to Jesus more quickly. Compare that to his initial reaction in Luke 5:8. What was the difference in Peter's mindset?
