## Main Idea:

When false teachers assailed Gentile believers with the heretical idea that circumcision and law keeping were necessary for salvation, forceful correction was needed to affirm the authentic biblical gospel of salvation by grace through faith in Christ alone. That correction came from the apostles and elders, including Peter, Paul and James, who convened a council at Jerusalem to address the matter.
