The Final Passover

Main Idea:

With His sacrifice only hours away, Jesus observed the Passover with His disciples. One of them would be confronted as the betrayer.

#1 What is the purpose of the gospels within the canon scripture?

#2 How can studying the gospels deepen our relationship with Jesus?

#3 What did the Passover memorialize?

Did it also foreshadow Christ's sacrifice on the cross? How?

#4 To what was Jesus referring in Matthew 26:18 when He said "My time is near"?

Do you see other evidences of Jesus' divine knowledge and sovereign control in 26:17-30? List them.

#5 In 26:21, the disciples excluding Judas all called Jesus "Lord." Judas, However, in 26:25 called Jesus "Ribbi." Do you see significance in this difference? Explain?

#6 In what way did Jesus encourage the disciples on this occasion that His death would be the end?
