Main Idea:

Peter concludes his first epistle by giving the believers in the churches of Asia Minor instructions for standing firm in the midst of persecution and hardship.

Outline:

- 1) To stand firm during difficult times, be subject to the leadership of the local church
- 2) To stand firm during difficult times, be humble
 - Clothe yourself with humility toward others
 - Cultivate humility generally, and particularly when engulfed in hard times
- 3) To stand firm in the face of hardship, remember that the energy is real, and be prepared to resist his attacks

Questions for further contemplation and application after the message:	
#1	David is one biblical example of one on whom God poured His blessing following a time of being humble and faithful. What other faithful men and women in Scripture share a similar testimony?
#2	Who is the ultimate example of humility? In what way?
#3	How does humility among believers build unity in the local church?
	How does our unity help us to remain faithful during challenging times?
