February 4, 2024 1 Thessalonians 5:4-11 The Day of the Lord Part 2 - How to Live While We Wait

Main Idea:

As believers in the Lord Jesus, we must diligently pursue holiness as we live in this present fallen and sometimes hostile world as we await His return. Doing so requires that we take stock in our citizenship in His kingdom, remain vigilant and be arrayed in His spiritual armor.

Outline:

Three instructions for living faithfully and growing in holiness day by day as the days grow darker and Christ's return draws near:

- 1. We must understand our blessed position as believers in Jesus and see to it that our approach to daily living aligns accordingly.
- 2. We must strive to live faithfully as "sons of light and sons of day." Doing so requires two things of us:
 - We must live vigilantly (v.6)
 - We must be spiritually armored (v.v. 7,8).
 - ♦ The breastplate of faith and love
 - ♦ The helmet of the hope of salvation
- 3. We must make our meditation the strengthening fact that our true eternal home is in heaven with our Lord.
