

November 9, 2025 2 Samuel 6 Real Worship

Main Idea:

Not long after David was made king over all Israel he took action to bring the Ark of the Covenant to its proper place – in the sanctuary in a centralized location (Jerusalem) accessible to Israel's priests and people. This important action would restore the ability of the nation to worship Yahweh according to His design. After a hasty and ill-conceived first attempt which resulted in God's judgment, the Ark was successfully brought to Jerusalem with David leading the way joyfully dancing before Yahweh with all his might.

From the occasion, four lessons about real worship come to light.

- 3. Real worship is received by God who fills the hearts of His worshipers with joy.
