1 Peter 4:1 – 11 Instructions for Striving After Holiness, Part 3

Main Idea:

Life in this present fallen world can be difficult for us as disciples of Jesus. The enemy's snares and the hostility of the unbelieving can distract us and impede our pursuit of holiness. But in Christ, we're able to overcome these challenges as we arm ourselves with the necessary perspectives, commitments and priorities for engaging in spiritual combat.

To strive after holiness successfully as Christians, we must arm ourselves with:

- 1. The right mindset dead to sin and alive in Christ (v.v. 1-2)
- 2. The right expectation persecution (v.v. 3-4)
- 3. The right understanding of God's character (v.v. 5 6)

- 5. The right attitude love (v.v. 8 –9)
- 6. The right commitment faithful service (v.v. 10 11)
