Main Idea

Questions for further contemplation and application after the message:

- 1) The Jews were generally prejudiced against Samaritans, and looking ahead to 4:27, it seems that the disciples had also been infected with this sinful disposition. Is prejudice still a barrier that can hold Christians back from sharing the gospel with others?
 - If so, how can we overcome it?
- 2) Read Romans 2 and 3. How do these chapters of Scripture help us with any kind of prejudice problem?
 - How can we better guard against prejudice and the closely related sin of self-righteousness?
 - With whom should we share the gospel?
 - Often, Jesus sought out the weak or disadvantaged. Why? Read 1 Corinthians 1:18-31 for additional insights.
- 3) How might you explain the doctrine of eternal security to a brother or sister in Christ having a difficult time understanding it?
 - What Scripture texts would you use?
