Part 5: Be a Prayer Warrior

Ephesians 6:18

Main Idea:

Prayer is an indescribably amazing privilege for the believer. Through prayer we commune with the God of the universe, lift our voices in His praise and ask Him to provide us with wisdom and comfort and to meet our needs. But because God invites us to pray and because He works through our petitions, prayer is an equally awesome responsibility for us and we must not approach it lazily, or worse, skeptically.

In Ephesians 6:18, Paul includes prayer as part of the believer's spiritual armor, and tell us how to be prayer warriors through whom the Lord works as we serve Him in this present world.
