The Door of the Sheep

Main Idea

Jesus is the door; if anyone enters through Him, he will be saved, and will go in and out of the pasture.

Outline

Jesus discloses three truths of vital importance about Himself and about the blessed life He gives to His believers.

1. The first and foundational truth that Jesus reveals is that He is personally the door into salvation.

3 clarifying points:

- Jesus is the door into salvation personally
- Jesus is the door into salvation exclusively
- Jesus is the door into salvation certainly

2. The second truth Jesus discloses is that when we enter into salvation through faith in Him we gain access to inexhaustible spiritual provision.

3. The third truth Jesus discloses is that He delivers abundant life to all who enter salvation through Him.

Questions for further contemplation and application after the message:

#1 What is the gospel? How would you explain it to an unbelieving friend?

#2 Read John 9. Why did the Pharisees expel the man who received sight from Jesus from the synagogue?

Should believers expect persecution for their faith in Jesus today?

#3 Why do you think the Pharisees refused to believe that Jesus is the Messiah?

#4 What did Jesus mean when He said “Truly, truly I am the door of the sheep”?

#5 Once saved, how can a believer know that his salvation in Christ is eternally secure?

#6 When does the abundant life begin for the believer in Jesus?
