Main Idea

Jesus, the Son of God, is born in Bethlehem.

Outline

Two things evident in Luke's record that will help us to better know and understand the occasion of the birth of Jesus.

- 1) Because the birth of Jesus was the result of God's plan, the timing and circumstances of the event were always completely within His sovereign control.
 - Two evidences of God's sovereignty in the circumstances leading up to the Lord's birth:
 - A. Joseph and Mary went to Bethlehem, where Jesus was born in fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy (Micah 5:2), seemingly to satisfy the taxation decree of a pagan king.
 - B. God's choice of Mary and Joseph fulfilled the promise/prophecy of 2 Samuel 7 and 1 Chronicles 17, and gave Jesus the rightful title to David's throne.
- 2) In the circumstances of the lowly birth of Jesus, we glimpse a striking preview of His mission of redemption.
 - The details of the birth of Jesus
 - The glimpse of His mission

- 2) How will the second coming of Jesus differ from His first coming?
