Main Idea

The church at Thessalonica thrived in spite of the adversity of persecution that its people experienced. As Paul recalled the church's faithfulness, three characteristics came to light that explained its spiritual prosperity and powerful testimony.

Three Marks (Characteristics) of a Thriving Church

- 1. A thriving church is one in which the Lord is imitated
 - 3 basic instructions for the imitation of Christ
 - To imitate Christ we must pursue holiness
 - To imitate Christ we must love others sacrificially
 - To imitate Christ we must pursue holiness
- 2. A thriving church is one from which the gospel shines forth
- 3. A thriving church is one in which the return of Jesus is eagerly anticipated
