Isaiah 53:10 - 12

Main Idea:

Seven centuries before the cross, Isaiah describes the redemptive work of Jesus in his prophecy of the Suffering Servant.

5. In verse 11, Yahweh said, "My Servant will justify the many as He will bear their iniquities." How would you explain that declaration to an unbeliever?
6. In what way or ways does Isaiah's prophecy of Yahweh's Servant strengthen your faith?
