Angels – Part 3

Selected Texts

Main Idea:

As God's ministers, His holy angels serve Him with their worship, by attending Him, and through their work of carrying out, at His direction, certain aspects of His rule.

Outline:

- 1) God's holy angels serve Him through their worship
 - Isaiah 6:1-4

 - Luke 2:7 – 14

 - Revelation 4

- 2) God's angels serve Him by attending Him
 - Ezekiel 1:1-11; 1:22 – 2:1

- 3) God's angels serve Him by carrying out certain aspects of His rule (Psalm 103:19-21)
 - Daniel 10:11-14

Questions for further contemplation and application after the message:

#1 According to Hebrews c. 1, why/how is the Lord Jesus superior to Angels?

According to Hebrews 1:8, who is Jesus?

#2 Read Isaiah 6:1-3. In the message, Pastor Vaughn said that the seraphim near the throne cover their faces with their wings to shield themselves from the blazing holiness of God.

How should the fact that these sinless angelic beings worship God with such a great sense of awe and care impact our own worship?

#3 Ezekiel described the cherubim near God's throne in terms that defy our imagination (1:5-14).

What does their powerful, majestic appearance tell us about God, who created them, and whom they so eagerly serve?
