God made three major promises to Abram:

1. **Land | Tebchaws** — *that his descendants would inherit Canaan.*
2. **Nation | Haivneeg** — *that his offspring would become a great nation.*
3. **Blessing | Koob Hmoov** — *that through him all nations of the earth would be blessed.*

Isaac represents everything:

- *the fulfillment of God's promise*
- *the future of Abraham's descendants*
- *the continuation of God's covenant*
- *the hope of the coming blessing to the nations*




v1: “Some time later God tested Abraham.”




v3: “Early the next morning Abraham..

Surrender Unlocks God's Provision


*Kev tso siab qhib kev muab Vajtswv txoj kev npaj

tso kev tswj hwm tuag mus.*


Abraham only saw it after surrendering.
