"I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life"

Use these questions and resources during your study time or with your group.

RECAP: Every culture is telling a story - about who we are, why we're here, and what really matters. We take our questions to the culture around us, and listen for answers. But who is telling you the truth? Where do your deepest beliefs come from? In a world full of noise and competing voices, Jesus makes bold, clear claims about who He is—and what real life looks like.

MAIN POINTS

- Reroute
- Reorientate
- Remain

GETTING STARTED

- Have you ever had GPS give you terrible directions or take you somewhere strange? What happened?

SCRIPTURE

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **The message suggested that everyone is listening to some kind of "voice" for direction in life (culture, past experiences, fears, faith, etc.).** What voices or influences do you think shape the direction people take in life the most? Which ones do you personally find the hardest to sort through?
- **Jesus' statement "I am the way, the truth, and the life" suggests that faith is more about walking a path with a person than mastering a set of beliefs.** How does that idea compare with how you've typically thought about Christianity or spirituality?
- **Thomas openly admits, "We don't know the way," and Jesus meets him in that honesty.** Why do you think it can be difficult for people—spiritually or otherwise—to admit they don't know the way forward?

APPLICATION

- **Reroute:** The message described grace as the opportunity to "reroute" when we miss a turn rather than pretending everything is fine. *What do you think makes it hardest for people to admit they've taken a wrong turn in life? What tends to help someone actually change direction?*
- **Reorientate:** The idea of reorienting is about realigning our lives to "true north" instead of whatever voices are loudest around us. *When life feels confusing or overwhelming, what helps you regain clarity about what really matters?*
- **Remain:** Jesus described spiritual life as remaining connected to Him rather than having occasional spiritual highs. *What do you think helps a person stay connected to what matters most over the long run, especially when life gets busy or difficult?*

RESOURCES

- **Closing Prayer:** God, thank you for meeting us right where we are. You know the places in our lives where we feel confused, uncertain, or off course. Thank you that you don't give up on us when we miss a turn, but invite us to begin again. Help us learn to recognize your voice above all the others that compete for our attention. Give us the humility to reroute when we need to, the wisdom to reorientate our lives around what is true, and the courage to remain close to you one step at a time. We may not see the whole road ahead, but we trust that you are with us in the journey. Lead us in the next step we need to take. Amen.
