DISCUSSION GUIDE

- How is sex outside of marriage viewed by many of the people you know?
- How has the media influenced our attitudes about sex and singleness?
- SINGLES: Where are you most vulnerable? Straying from God's path or losing hope in the possibility of a great marriage? Explain?
- SINGLES: What are you doing today that will positively affect your tomorrow? (Egs: maybe you're guarding your heart or developing Christ-centered friendships, etc.)
- MARRIED: Satan trains people for divorce. What are you doing (or what do you need to do) to divorce-proof your marriage?
- MARRIED: Marriage is a covenant not a contract. Talk about what that means in your daily living? (refer to definitions above)
- What did God speak to you during this message? Discuss it?
- How can you begin to pray this week for your marriage? For your purity if you're single?

- Read 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8. What are God's desires for our sexuality? (4:3-8) How is the Christian's sexual conduct to be different from that of the non-Christian? (4:4-5) When a person rejects God's instructions on sexual behavior, what are they rejecting? (4:8) How can we wrong a person by our sexual behavior? What should motivate us to live a pure and holy life?
