1. Your _____ Body _____.

2. Your _____ Leaves _____.

We know that when this tent we live in now **is taken down** we will have **wonderful new bodies** in heaven, homes that will be ours forevermore, made by God himself. - *2 Corinthians 5:1 TLB*

3. _____ Will Face _____.

TWO JUDGMENTS

A. _____ Throne Judgment.

And I saw **a great white throne** and the one sitting on it. The earth and sky fled from his presence, but they found no place to hide. I saw **the dead**, both great and small, standing before God’s throne. And the books were opened, including **the Book of Life**... B. Judgment _____ Of Christ.

For we must all appear before **the judgment seat of Christ**, so that each of us may receive what is due us for the things done while **in the body, whether good or bad**. - *2 Corinthians 5:10 NIV*

“Behold, I am coming soon! My **reward is with me**, and I will give to everyone according to **what he has done**. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.” - *Revelation 22:12-13 NIV*

So whether we are here in this body or away from this body, **our goal is to please him**. - *2 Corinthians 5:9 NLT*
