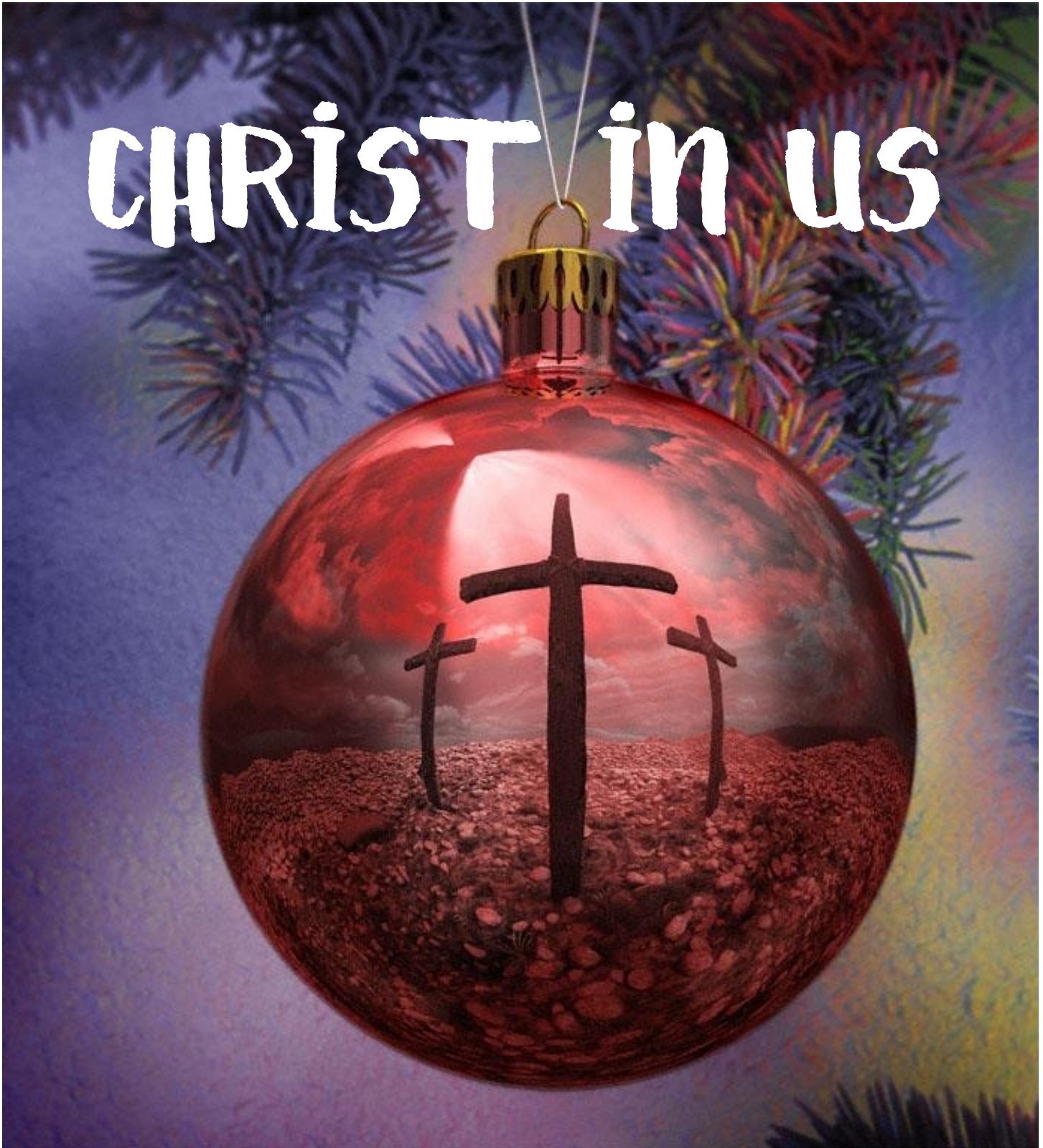

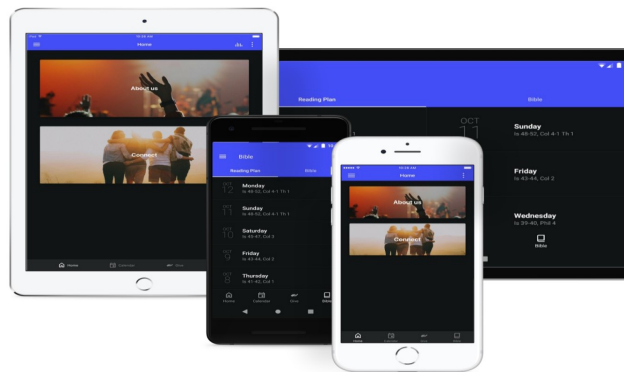
Donations of funds to purchase gift cards for housing insecure HISD families.

ELBC will purchase gift cards from local vendors for the purchase of Christmas gifts and essential goods that will help the families in need through the holiday season.



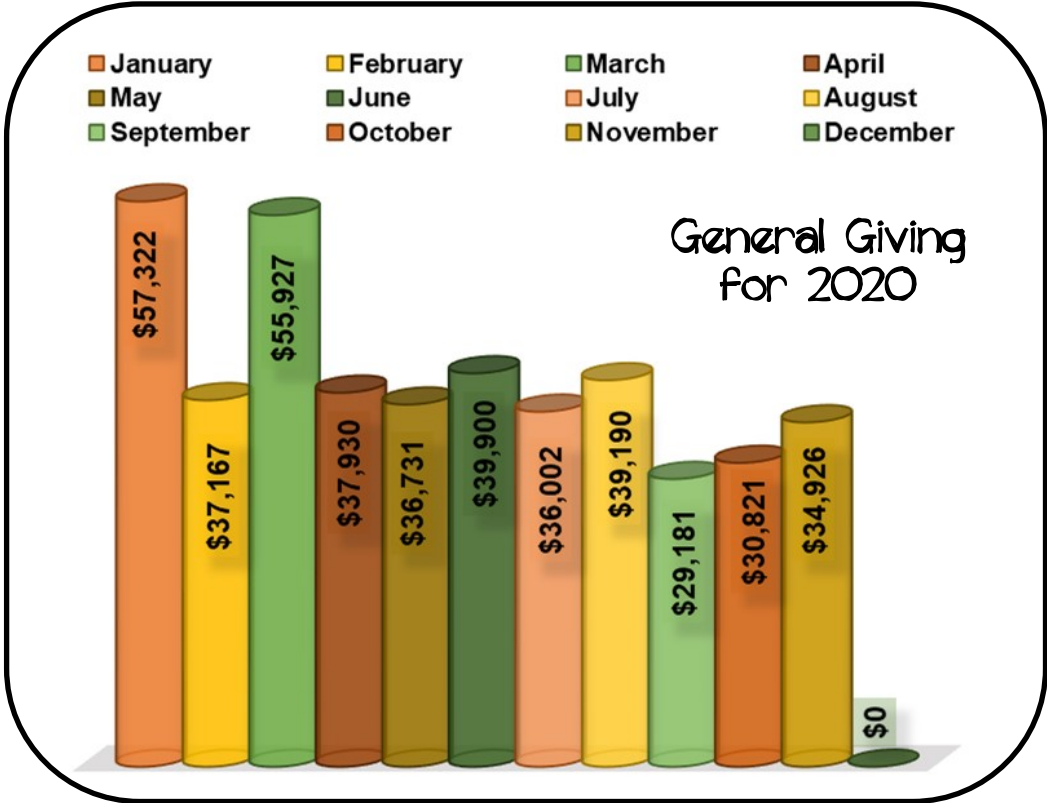
