Communal Reading – ENOCH BARRIGAH

Leader: Please join me in today's communal reading – I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Worshippers: For Christ also suffered for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, that He might bring us to God, after being put to death in the fleshly realm but made alive in the spiritual realm.

Leader: God presented Him as propitiation through faith in His blood, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His restraint God passed over the sins previously committed.

Worshippers: We are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus. Therefore if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation; old things have passed away, and look, new things have come.

Leader: Now everything is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that is, in Christ, God was reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them.

Worshippers: May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

Leader: I meditate on all You have done; I reflect on the work of Your hands.

Worshippers: He has rescued us from the domain of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Leader: This is the word of the Lord.

All: Thanks be to God.
