BRYAN & KARLY CHITTENDEN (WITH CHILDREN)

- Speaker 1 Today we light the 4th Advent Candle of love, though we must specify Whose love we're observing.
- Speaker 2 It is not our love, but rather God's love; love that is gracious and steadfast though ours is often petty and fleeting.
- Speaker 1 It is this love the prophet Isaiah has in mind when he says:
- Congregation [The fourth candle, the last purple candle, is lit while the congregation reads] "I will recount the steadfast love of the Lord, according to all that the Lord has granted us, according to His compassion, according to the abundance of His steadfast love."

Men – For He said, "Surely they are My people."

Women - And He became their Savior.

Speaker 2 – The birth of Jesus is God's love made flesh.

Speaker 1 – Christ was born to us not as reward for our love—but as the outpouring of God's eternal, abundant compassion.

Speaker 2 – Advent thus affirms what 1 John confesses:

Congregation – This is love, not that we have loved God, but that God loved us and sent his Son.
