Worship

Greek: Proskuneo

Kiss, Bow, Reverence

To kiss the hand toward / to prostrate oneself

Hebrew: Shachah

Bow, Prostrate, Reverence, Pay Homage

It involves adoration, confession, prayer, thanksgiving, and similar acts.

Worship is that intimacy that keeps us connected and produces fruit as a result.

Worship is Semantic

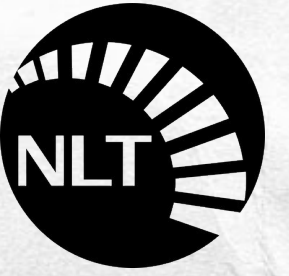
Worship that is Spirit:

- Empowered from the human spirit by the **Holy Ghost**

Worship that is Truth:

- Aligns with **GOD's** revealed nature
 - Centered on **Christ**
 - Aligned with Scripture

Feel After HIM

JESUS enjoys pursuit.

Praying and doing what worked before but not getting the same response?

Sing **HIM** a song and reflect on the lyrics

Tell **HIM** why you want to feel **HIM**

Tell **HIM** what you think of **HIM**

Invoke **HIS** Name aloud

Change position

Dance before **HIM** / dance with **HIM**

Engage in specific thanksgiving

Read scriptures aloud
