Why We Bargain with God

- 1. We are desperate and have nowhere else to turn
- 2. We need God to solve our crisis
- 3. We need something from God
- 4. We want something from God

Bargaining with God...

 Fails to recognize God's sovereignty & just judgement – Abraham (Gen 18:16-33)

Three Questions Related to God's Sovereignty

- a. Is God in control of all things?
- b. Does God work in your life for your good and His glory?
- c. Does God have the right to do with your life as He wills?
- 2. Fails to acknowledge the foolishness of bargaining with God Jephthah (Judges 11:30-31)

Why is it Foolish to Bargain with God?

- a. Because we have nothing to bargain with
- b. Because our relationship with God is based on mercy and grace NOT on what we think we have earned or think we deserve
- Fails to affirm that God owes us nothing David (2 Sam 12:14-23) What Do We Deserve from God?
 - a. We deserve death and hell (Rom 6:23)
 - b. We don't deserve the love & grace that God gives us (Rom 3:20-24)
- Fails to respond to God with trust and obedience Hezekiah (Isa 39:8)

- Will you surrender to God believing whatever He chooses to do with your life is for your good and His glory? Or...
- Will you serve God conditionally never experiencing the presence and power of God at work in your life?
