Negative words: Inflammatory words, hurtful words, slanderous words, filthy words

"Many things are opened by mistake, but none so frequent as one's mouth" ~ Unknown

Not all speech is sinful. The Bible identifies specific uses of the tongue as sinful: unwholesome word (Eph 4:29), deceitful mouth/devious speech (Pro 4:24), filthy silly talk (Eph 5:4), insult for insult (1 Pet 3:9-10), cursing (Psa 10:7, Rom 3:13-14)

Gossip – "one who reveals secrets". The intent is to build oneself up by making others look bad (Pro 11:23, Pro 16:28, Pro 26:20, 1 Tim 5:13)

Slander – "an accuser who intends to harm others" (Pro 10:18, 1 Cor 4:13, Lists of sins - Mk 7:22, Rom 1:30, 2 Cor 12:20, Eph 4:31, Col 3:8, 2 Tim 3:3)

Lying – intentional violation of truth or telling a lie as truth (Jn 8:44, Rom 1:24-25, 1 Jn 2:21-22)

QUESTIONS TO ASK BEFORE YOU SPEAK (Eph 4:19-5:2)

- 1. Does it build others up?
- 2. Does it offer grace to the hearer?
- 3. Will it grieve the Holy Spirit?
- 4. Is it kind and compassionate?
- 5. Does it show forgiveness?
- 6. Does it imitate God?
- 7. Is it spoken in love?

QUESTIONS TO ASK YOURSELF

- 1. How have your words impacted the people around you this week? At work, at home, on social media?
- 2. Will you make a commitment this week to "guard your words" by asking seven simple questions before you speak?
