1. Brings you closer to God & clarifies your purpose in life
 - God created us to know Him personally, 17:3
 - God created us to glorify Him through obedience, 17:4, 22
2. Prepares you to live in a world that is hostile to the Gospel
 - To know God intimately, 17:9
 - To keep you faithful to God, 17:10-12
 - To produce joy through turmoil, 17:13
 - To protect you from evil, 17:14-16
 - To make you holy, 17:17-19
3. Challenges you to unite with other Christ followers ...
 - So that God's people will be one, 17:20-22
 - For unity in the body of Christ, the church, 17:23
 - And focus on your future in heaven, 17:24-25
 - Showing love for one another, 17:26
