Mary, the mother of Jesus, teaches moms how to have radical faith as you raise your children to love and serve God.

Characteristics of Radical Faith

1. Mary's FAITH in the sovereignty of God overcame her fears of the unknown
 - God's timing is different than our timing, 1:26-27
 - God's presence is with us even when we are afraid, 1:28-30
 - Our faith is proportionate to our relationship with God, 1:31-34, 37-38
2. Mary's OBEDIENCE to the will God overcame what others would think of her unique pregnancy
 - What would Joseph, her parents, and her friends think of her? 1:35-36
 - Obedience believes in the God of the impossible, 1:37
3. Mary's FAITHFULNESS in raising the son of God overcame any feelings of inadequacy as a mother to raise the Messiah
 - Mary's faith defined her faithfulness, 1:38
 - Mary loved her son unconditionally even when she did not understand, Mk 3:20-21, 31-35
 - Mary guided Jesus to be the Messiah she knew Him to be, Jn 3:1-12
