Who is Jesus Christ?

A Christian understanding of our relationship with God

God created us in His image and in the beginning - we were perfect, holy, and righteous. Adam and Eve, God's first created human beings and representatives of mankind, disobeyed God by eating of the tree of knowledge of good and evil. Their sin brought God's wrath and severed their perfect relationship with God.

Since our sin separated us from God, only God could accomplish two things necessary to restore our relationship with God. First, He had to satisfy His wrath towards sin which is called expiation meaning we are justified – declared not guilty & righteous before God (Justify – just if I'd never sinned) (Rom 4:25-5:2). Second, He had to prepare a perfect sacrifice to atone for the sins of mankind. Atonement refers to a covering for sin and is sometimes referred to as propitiation (Rom 3:23-26).

God had to send the perfect sacrifice to die in our place. That person was God's only Son, Jesus Christ, who was God in the flesh (John 1:1-17). God's Word tells us when we believe what Christ did for us by faith, confess our sin, and trust God to save us, we will be saved (Rom 10:9-10,13). As evidence of our faith, we live our lives in accordance with the commandments contained in God's Word and share God's message of salvation with others.

What is salvation? "God has united you with Christ Jesus. For our benefit God made him to be wisdom itself. Christ made us right with God; he made us pure and holy, and he freed us from sin." 1 Cor 1:30 NLT

In light of what was said, I will explain the question, "Who is Jesus Christ?"

Who is Jesus Christ?

- 1. Jesus Christ is God, Col 1:15-18
 - a. He existed with the Father He was not created (Jn 1:1, 18, Jn 10:30, Jn 17:21, Phil 2:5-6, Col 1:17, Col 2:9-10)

- b. He was the sinless Son of God (1 Pet 2:22, 2 Cor 5:21, Heb 4:15, 1 Jn 3:5) who claimed to be God (Jn 5:18, Jn 10:33)
- c. He came to forgive sin, as only God could do (Mk 2:7, Matt 9:6, 1 Pet 2:24)
- 2. Jesus Christ became Man, Col 1:19-20
 - a. He was born to the virgin Mary (Isa 7:14, Matt 1:22-23, Lk 1:34-35)
 - b. He was human (attributes Jn 4:6, 19:28, Lk 24:40-43, Mk 6:34, Jn 11:35, Heb 14:15, Jn 19:30)
 - c. He died on the cross in our place so we can be forgiven and reconciled to God (ransom Matt 20:28, Rom 3:24, 1 Pet 1:18, to pay penalty for sin Rom 3:24, 1 Jn 2:2, 4:10, took God's wrath Rom 5:9, died so we would be forgiven Jn 1:29, Eph 1:7, Col 1:13-14, and reconciled to God 2 Cor 5:18, Col 1:19-20)
- 3. Jesus Christ rose from the dead, Rom 8:31-39
 - a. The reality of His resurrection (Matt 28:6, Acts 1:3, 1 Cor 15:1-4, 17, Rev 1:5, 18, Col 1:18, Jn 2:19-22, Rom 6:9)
 - b. Witnesses saw His resurrection & ascension (Angels Matt 28:2-6, Mary Magdalene Mk 16:9, two on Emmaus Lk 24:31-35, Peter Lk 24:34, disciples Jn 20:19-20, more than 500 1 Cor 15:4-6, ascension Acts 1:9)
 - c. He is in heaven as Mediator and Savior waiting for the day we will come again as Just Judge (Rom 8:31-34, 2 Tim 4:1, Acts 17:30-31, Rev 19:11)
- 4. Jesus reconciled us to God to serve Him, Col 1:21-23, 27-29
 - a. We are declared holy & righteous through Christ (1 Cor 1:30, 1 Thess 5:23)
 - Christ took our sin upon Himself (1 Peter 2:24-25, 2 Cor 5:21, Gal 3:13, 1 Pet 3:18, 1 Jn 3:5, Heb 7:26)
 - c. Christ expects to work through us to lead us to live for Him (2 Cor 5:15, 1 Pet 2:24)

In Summary:

- My identity: I am a Christ follower (Christian)
- My responsibility: I follow Christ in every area of my life
- My Actions: I live as a Christ follower according to the Bible

If we do not answer that question from a biblical perspective, the world will remain in darkness and separated from God for eternity
