SEVEN Simple Tips on Praying the Scriptures

- Insert names and places as you use Scripture in prayer You (Rom 8:1-38), the church (Eph 1:15-23), America (Neh 1:3-11)
- 2. Find Scriptures that relate to your problem and use them in prayer Discouraged (1 Pet 1:6-9), Fear (Psa 27:1-14), Worry (Phil 4:6-8), the Mouth & Heart (Psa 19:14)
- Repeat prayers in the Bible for people who need Christ, families, churches, our nation, and the world Salvation (2 Cor 7:10 NLT), Prayer for God's people (John 17)
- 4. Pray using promises from the Bible knowing they will be answered God of the impossible (Lk 18:27), God will cleanse sin (1 Jn 1:9), God will supply all my needs (Phil 4:19)
- Use Scripture to praise God, thank God, and ask God to meet your needs and the needs of others God's love never changes (Psa 136), God created me and knows me intimately (Psa 139), My hope is in God alone (Psa 42)
- 6. Use Scripture to pray against satanic attack the way Jesus did Anger (James 1:19-20), Rebellious (13:17), Lukewarm (Deut 8:11-14)
- Use Scripture that reminds you of what God desires to do in your life to put off sin and put on Christ (Eph 4:17-6:20, Gal 5:1-26, 2 Pet 1:3-8, Col 3:1-17)
