What About Baptism?

Who Should Be Baptized and When Should A Person Be Baptized?

- 1. Every person who believes Christ died for their sin and receives Christ into their hearts but when they believed, ...they were baptized, Acts 8:12
- 2. Baptism always followed salvation in the Bible those who accepted his message were baptized, Acts 2:41

Why Should A Person Be Baptized?

- 1. Because Jesus set the example Jesus...was baptized by John, Mark 1:9
- 2. Because Jesus commanded it ...baptizing them, Matt 28:19-20
- 3. Because baptism signifies our obedience to Christ baptizing them, Matt 28:19-20
- 4. Because baptism symbolizes the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ having been buried with him in baptism and raised with him, Col 2:12
- 5. Because baptism symbolizes the believer's new life in Christ ...we to may live a new life, Rom 6:4
- 6. Because baptism symbolizes our unity with Christ and fellow believers one Lord, one faith, one baptism, Eph 4:5

What is the Meaning of Baptism?

Baptism has no saving grace but it is important because it is a symbol of the believer's new life in Christ. It means you have:

- 1. Repented (turned away from) your sin repent and be baptized, Acts 2:38
- Believed in Jesus and accepted Him as your personal Savior John=s
 baptism was a baptism of repentance. He told the people to believe...in
 Jesus, Acts 19:4
- 3. Started a new life with Christ ...we to may live a new life, Rom 6:4

Why Should We Be Baptized by Immersion?

- 1. The word baptize means to immerse John also was baptizing...because there was plenty of water, John 3:23
- 2. Jesus was baptized by immersion as soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water, Matt 3:16
- 3. Only immersion symbolizes the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ we were therefore buried with him through baptism into death, Rom 6:4
