## Does Stewardship Include More than Money? Series: Questions about Stewardship

<u>Truth</u>: Surrendering everything to God is a matter of the heart. When the heart is right with God, you will surrender your time, your spiritual gifts, and your financial resources to bear spiritual fruit and glorify God.

## What Does Stewardship Mean to God?

- 1. **Accountability** God made you a steward over all He has given you.
- 2. **Responsibility** God expects you to be responsible with the spiritual gifts, spiritual fruit, and all your resources.
- 3. **Opportunity** God gives you opportunities every day to be witnesses for Him and disciple others.

## What Can You Surrender to God?

- 1. Surrender your life to God (Romans 12:1-2) God will transform your heart and mind and use your life to build His kingdom when you give Him full access.
- 2. Surrender your time (Col 4:5) use your time for prayer, bible study, serving God in the church, sharing Truth with others, and building relationships that leads to making disciples.
- 3. Surrender your spiritual gifts (1 Cor 14:12) God uses your spiritual gifts to build up the church and reach people who do not know Christ personally.
- 4. Surrender your heart (Eph 4:1-3) God uses a humble heart who readily meets the needs of the people around you (emotional, spiritual, physical, and mental).
- 5. Surrender your money and resources (2 Cor 9:6-8) your tithes and offerings are crucial to building God's kingdom.

## **Bottom Line**

As Christ followers, you are stewards of what God has given you and He expects you to surrender what He has given you for His use and His glory.
