- 21. And when Jesus was passed over again by ship unto the other side, much people gathered unto him: and he was nigh unto the sea.
- 22. And, behold, there cometh one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name; and when he saw him, he fell at his feet,
- 23. And besought him greatly, saying, My little daughter lieth at the point of death: I pray thee, come and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live.
- 24. And Jesus went with him; and much people followed him, and thronged him.
- 25. And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years...

# He besought (begged) – Jesus to come! Temporal need brought him there...

#### Jesus went with him... vs. 24

The Woman

Jesus- Only instance I can find – Distracted..

He was delayed...

#### Jairus:

Watching.

Worrying.

Wondering.

#### The news:

The message no parent wants- While Jesus was meeting someone else's needs, his only little girl died. She's dead.

Don't bother Jesus. Or maybe better- Don't bother with Jesus!

He's too late. She's dead. What can anyone do now?

#### Jesus: vs. 36

#### Jesus to Jairus:

Will you trust me, believe in me, when everything in you and around you screams not to?!

## Easy? NO!

Personally.
Historically and intelligently.
Add the crowd!

"Don't be afraid. Believe. Trust me."

Jairus: Satan- "not fang marks on the skin but lies on the heart" -

- How can you trust Jesus when God seems to be not interested enough in the things of your heart?
- Delay: How when Jesus was too late.
- Dead: How when nothing in this world could change things now.
   Dead. Final.

## He chose to journey with Jesus!

\*\*\*\*Have you began a journey? Made some progress? Still struggling but closer?

Jesus- vs. 39 –

A Word of hope for a broken dad - "She sleeps"

The Crowd: Another Road Block!

Wailing

**Laughing and scorning** 

Jesus: vs. 40- "put them all out"

Sometimes – you have to shut off the noise, the crowd, the doubters, the...

What could they do? As helpless as Jairus!

## **III. The Savior**

#### A. What Jesus showed.

Sat down by her.

Took her hand.

# B. What Jesus said - Holding her hand.

Vs. 41 – "Talitha"

Only time!

"A diminutive term of endearment" (Tim Keller)

Pet name – "Honey", "Sugar", "Lit'l bit"

As a mother – takes her hand and holds it and speaks her special name...

## Then, "Cumi". –

Not Resurrection!

Just, "Get up. It's time to get up". And she did.

The picture: If I have you by the hand, death is nothing but

sleep. (Tim Keller)
