Are YOU ready?

"I'm ready!"

Paul- 2 Timothy 4:6- "I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand."

Vs. 8 – "love his appearing"

Jesus- "Be ready!"- over and over – Ready!

Repeat - "I'm ready!"

One of the best things we can do in any relationship is

- 1. To Recognize the 2nd law of thermodynamics in relationships! Things left to themselves tend to run down, fall apart
- 2. To evaluate and re-engage

Invest – daily!

3. To be aware of the blessings of doing so... and the dangers of not doing so!

Last week- we looked at several factors that negatively affect our walk with the Lord-

Distance

Delay

Distraction

Deception

The Lord several times – over and over- repeated not only the prophecy but the pointed emphasis on Choices and Consequences.

Marriage-

- Can I be married, and not act like it or live accordingly?
- Distinction Marriages can end; our relationship with Jesus can't!!!!

In the last times, there will be a massive disconnect -

"I am saved, so I can do what I want, live as I want..."

Smorgasbord, consumer mindset...

Jesus -

- NO!
- I love you too much to let you drift into danger and miss the wonder of loving and living with me in those last days!!
